We'll make it easy, you can select from the following options.

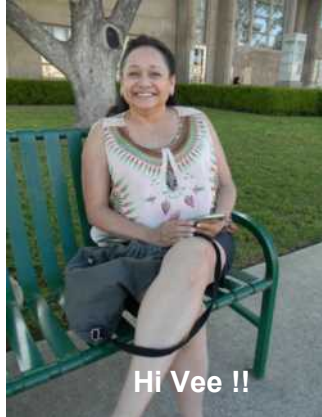
Members can pay their dues of \$35.00 at the June Meeting, Wednesday Breakfast or by mailing them to Barb at the following address:
