As a last note, if anyone has an idea for a cruise or an event, let The Cigar Guy know!

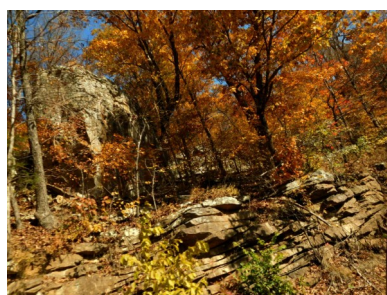
EDITOR'S CORNER

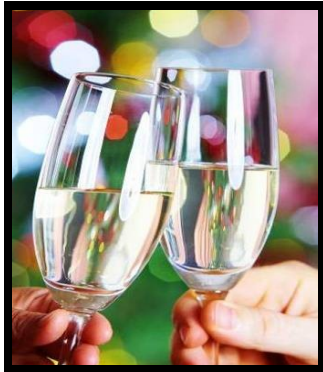
