We will be taking off again in middle/late October for the west coast to take care of family matters, and that issue may be late as well, hence the advanced advisory.

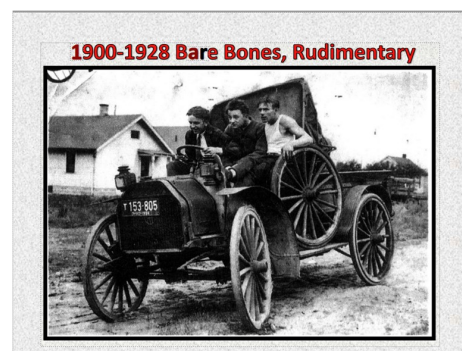
