

Kenneth Bible is still in business at his unique business location in Johnson City. He is a master repairman of starters, alternators and generators, and in my experience, is the best in the area. Having had a bad experience with alternator repair at a certain repair shop in Marble Falls, Kenneth undid the poor repair made by that shop and got it right, then ran the alternator on his homemade "dynamometer". He is on 290, about 3 blocks west of 281 in Johnson City.

If you take an item there to be repaired, it may take some time, as he has a raft of jobs before yours, so be patient—its worth the wait, and his shop is worth the visit. It reminds me of an old-time blacksmith shop. If I were younger, I'd like to be his apprentice. When he is gone, an irreplaceable talent will be lost.







