THE FINAL FLIGHT

We note the last wheels up of Mike Dohrse, Founding and Lifetime Member in August (noted in minutes, this issue). Mike is survived by his wife Norma Jean and one child. He retired from the United States Air Force as a bird Colonel, as pilot of and commander of a B-52 squadron, having entered military service as an enlisted man in the Marine Corps, and reenlisted into the Air Force, being one of the few to be promoted from enlisted to commissioned officer. After retirement, he and Norma Jean moved to their retirement home on Lake Buchanan where he helped found our Club and was a long-term Activity Director, with one of his accomplishments being a trip he planned and led to Prude Ranch in the Davis Mountains. When Mike led a trip, the scheduled time was wheels up and moving, rather than a gathering time, still being militarily precise. At present, no plans for services were announced.

Glenn Gavin, a long-time member of the Club, and a long time resident of Liberty Hill passed away suddenly at his home. He still had his old race car, as well as his nice mid-50s Thunderbird. He and Benny and Mary Ellen Ledesma were very close friends. He was a well-known resident of Liberty Hill, and lived in a beautiful home in the old section of the town.

He had attended our Show and Shine at O'Reilly's the very evening before his death. He will be very much missed.

He is survived by his wife, Glenda.
